

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website. They ensure that the website works properly and collect information to improve the user experience. Cookies may be set by us (first-party cookies) or by third parties (third-party cookies).

When you first visit our website, you will be asked to accept our cookies. You can then manage your choices yourself at any time. [Adjust your cookie preferences here.](#)

We use the following types of cookies:

Functional or necessary cookies

These are necessary for our website to function correctly. For example, they remember your preferences.

Analytical cookies

We use these cookies to collect statistics on the use of our website (such as via Google Analytics) to improve the content and user experience. This data is anonymised. In some cases, we may rely on our legitimate interest to place these cookies; in other cases, your consent is required.

Marketing cookies

These cookies are designed to track visitors as they visit different websites. The aim is to display adverts that are relevant and appealing to you. We may only place these after obtaining your explicit consent.

Third-party cookies

Third parties sometimes place cookies via our website. If you notice that other cookies are being placed via our website, please notify us immediately so that we can make the necessary adjustments. These third parties are responsible for the cookies they place, and their own privacy policies apply.
